WHAT IS THE CITIZENS' POLICE ACADEMY?

Citizens have always been interested in the role of the police in their community. The Citizens' Police Academy (CPA) will provide participants with an insight into police operations. While attending the CPA, participants will be introduced to a wide variety of Department functions. The CPA is not intended to make citizens into police officers, it was however developed to encourage citizens to learn more about their police department. Participants will become familiar with the actual role of the police and, in turn, police officers will benefit from the wealth of knowledge that citizens can provide about their community.

The Smithfield Police Department is a service organization. To provide the best services to our community, the police and the citizens must understand each other's points of view and work closely together to ensure the safety of the community.

The Citizens' Police Academy consists of 8 consecutive weeks of training. Sessions will be held on **Thursday evenings from 6:30 to 8:30 p.m.** beginning **October 11, 2018**. To enroll, citizens must first complete the Registration form. Applicants will receive notification informing them of their acceptance once their application has been processed. Seating is limited and applications will be accepted on a first-come, first served basis.

The mission of the CPA is to develop citizen awareness and understanding, and is provided free-of-charge to residents of Smithfield and employees of a town business that are 18 and older.
